APPLICATION CONDITIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS TO MASTER'S WITH THESIS AND DOCTORATE PROGRAMS

The applications of students who apply from the International Student quotas are taken according to the Isparta University of Applied Sciences Directive for Application, Admission and Registration of Prospective Students from Abroad to Graduate Programs, and the procedures are carried out accordingly.

a) Graduation Degree

1. For Master's programs with/without thesis, being a graduate of an undergraduate program lasting at least four years, and for doctorate programs, excluding the preparatory class, being a graduate of an undergraduate or master's program with a thesis lasting at least five years is required.
2. Candidates applying for a doctoral program with an undergraduate degree must have an undergraduate graduation grade point average of at least 3.00 out of a 4.00 system or an equivalent score. The higher education institutions to which the programs

graduated from are affiliated must be accepted by YÖK. A school recognition certificate must be obtained from the YÖK recognition and equivalence services department (<https://denklik.yok.gov.tr/>).

b) Language Proficiency

1. Regarding Turkish proficiency level:

- a) Candidates whose language of the program they applied to is Turkish must have a Turkish Proficiency Certificate issued by DİLMER, TÖMER, Yunus Emre Institute or Language Teaching Application and Research Centers of Universities indicating that their Turkish proficiency level is at least C1.
- b) Candidates who do not have a Turkish proficiency level of C1 are given a maximum of two semesters to bring their language proficiency to the C1 level. The registrations of the candidates who do not have a language proficiency certificate at least at C1 level at the end of this period are deleted.
- c) Turkish proficiency requirement is not sought from international students who have graduated from programs whose undergraduate or graduate education language is entirely Turkish in Turkey or abroad.
- ç) A Turkish Proficiency Certificate is not required from international students who apply to graduate programs that provide education in a foreign language by submitting documents proving that they are proficient in the relevant foreign language.

2. Regarding foreign language proficiency level:

- a) No foreign language exam requirement is sought from prospective students from abroad who will apply for master's programs in which education is conducted in Turkish.
- b) For graduate education programs in a foreign language (English), a foreign language requirement is not sought from those who graduate from undergraduate programs that provide one hundred percent English education or from candidates whose native language is English. Other candidates must have obtained at least 65 from one of the YDS/e-YDS and YÖKDİL exams or a score equivalent to this score from another exam accepted by the Interuniversity Board.
- c) In order to apply for doctorate programs in which education is conducted in Turkish, it is required to obtain at least 55 points from the central foreign language exams (YDS/e-YDS/YÖKDİL) accepted by the Council of Higher Education and the international foreign language exams whose equivalence is accepted, or an equivalent score from an exam whose equivalence is accepted by ÖSYM in the foreign language specified in the announcement text.
- ç) A higher foreign language score may be requested as a foreign language exemption condition in the student admission announcement of the graduate program applied for. The validity period of foreign language documents is five years from the date the exam result is announced for exams held by ÖSYM, for other equivalent exams, if no validity period is specified on the exam result document, 5 years, if specified, the relevant period is valid.
- d) For situations where a foreign language requirement is sought, a copy of the foreign language document prepared in English or Turkish and approved by the foreign representatives of the relevant countries must be uploaded to the system during the application.

c) Documents Required in the Application

Prospective students from abroad who meet the application conditions must upload the following documents via the platform specified in the announcement text during the application to the program:

1. Passport size photograph taken within the last 6 months (4.5cm x 6cm size).
2. Resume prepared in Turkish or English (optional).
3. Statement of Purpose (optional) explaining the student's aim for graduate education, studies, and projects.
4. Letter of Reference (optional) obtained from any faculty member in the program applied for.
5. For master's program applications, an approved copy of the undergraduate graduation certificate/diploma and transcript approved by foreign representatives and translated into Turkish or English (e-Government printout documents with a QR code are also valid for those who graduated from a higher education institution in Turkey).
6. For doctorate program applications, an approved copy of the undergraduate and master's graduation certificates/diplomas and transcripts obtained from sworn translation offices or T.R. Foreign Representatives and translated into Turkish or English (e-Government printout documents with a QR code are also valid for those who graduated from a higher education institution in Turkey).
7. For those who are citizens of the Republic of Turkey and completed their entire undergraduate education in a foreign country, including those who completed it in Turkish schools in a foreign country other than the TRNC, a School Recognition Certificate obtained from YÖK, Recognition and Equivalence Services Department.
8. A School Recognition Certificate obtained from YÖK from those who are foreign nationals and graduated from a higher education institution abroad. The higher education institutions to which the graduated programs are affiliated must be accepted by YÖK. A School Recognition Certificate must be obtained from YÖK, Recognition and Equivalence Services Department.

EVALUATION PRINCIPLES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. The evaluation of applications to the announced quotas and the resolution of objections to be made are carried out by the Foreign Student Admission Commission.
2. Unless special conditions for the program are specified in the announcement, candidates applying for master's programs according to the success scores to be obtained by adding 70% of the undergraduate graduation grade and 30% of the Turkish exam grade; Candidates applying for doctorate programs are ranked starting from the highest score according to the weighted averages formed by taking into account 50% of the master's graduation grade, 25% of the foreign language exam grade and 25% of the Turkish exam grade. For candidates who submit a grade in a four-point system for undergraduate graduation, their grades are calculated using the Equivalent of Grades in the 4-Point System to the 100-Point System conversion table announced by YÖK, and the foreign language exam grade equivalents are also calculated using the Foreign Language Exams Equivalences table announced by YÖK. The Turkish exam score of the candidate who does not have a Turkish exam score is considered zero. The score equivalents for the Turkish proficiency level are given below:

3. In case of equality in the evaluation, placement is made for the candidate with a higher diploma grade, and if the equality continues, for the younger candidate. Placement lists are created as a result of the ranking, with candidates equal to the announced quota as principal and the others as reserves.

4. In the event that no one prefers the quota allocated for a program for the admission of students from abroad or the quota is not filled, the remaining empty quotas may be transferred to other programs with the appropriate opinion of the Department, the proposal of the Institute Executive Board and the decision of the Senate. Only reserve candidates can benefit from the transferred quotas.

5. The Institute is free to fill or not to fill the announced quotas.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FROM INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS DURING FINAL REGISTRATION

(Final Registrations of International students Will Be in Person)

1. Candidates who are entitled to enroll in graduate programs register by applying to the Institute in person. Registration cannot be made by mail or through someone other than the candidate. However, registration can be made with persons authorized by a power of attorney issued by T.R. Foreign Representatives or T.R. Notaries.
2. The originals of all documents presented during the application and their approved Turkish translations obtained from sworn translation offices or T.R. Foreign Representatives must be submitted during registration.
3. The originals of the scholarship documents of the scholarship candidates and their approved Turkish translation from a notary public, sworn translation offices or T.R. Foreign Representatives must be submitted during registration.
4. The original passport and student visa and their Turkish translations obtained from sworn translation offices or T.R. Foreign Representatives must be submitted.
5. 4 biometric passport-size photographs (4.5cm x 6cm in size) taken within the last 6 months must be submitted.
6. Other documents requested by the T.R. Migration Management regarding residence registration are requested during registration. The application for a residence permit is made by the University, and the registration of the student who is not granted a Residence permit by the T.R. Migration Management is deleted.
7. A document proving that the tuition fee has been paid must be submitted.
8. Placement results are announced on the web page of the Institute on the date specified in the announcement text. An official acceptance letter is prepared by the University so that students who have gained the right to register can obtain a visa. Candidates who do not come to register within the specified period are deemed to have given up their right to register.

ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED DURING FINAL REGISTRATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. Candidates must submit the documents specified for final registration in a plastic cover file to the institute in person.
2. Registration cannot be done by mail.
3. The registrations of candidates who have a missing "as original" approval on the required documents, make false declarations and/or tamper with them will not be made even if they are successful in the exams. The registrations of students whose candidate registration or final registration has been made based on false information and documents will be deleted.
